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In the Memo. 1<sup>st</sup> cited , instructions were issued by Government with regard to the grant of compensatory holidays and it was ordered that a Government servant who is called to attend office on a holiday should be granted another day in its place when opportunity offers. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Director, women welfare, Hyderabad has sought for clarification whether with reference to the above orders, a government servant who is asked to attend office on a holiday can be granted compensatory leave immediately after attending the holiday turn even if he has casual leave to his credit, or granting compensatory leave has to be considered for the first time only after all the casual leave at the credit of the individual is exhausted.

2. It is hereby clarified that casual leave account does not in any way come in the way of compensatory leave account,. Both are separate and they cannot be joined together. When a government servant who is asked to attend office on a holiday for government work, he is eligible for compensatory leave in lieu of the work he attended on a government holiday. If a Government servant applied for compensatory holiday and if he is eligible for it, that holiday may also be granted irrespective of the fact that he applies for the grant of such leave immediately after attending the holiday turn and the fact that he has casual leave to his credit. The question of granting compensatory leave after casual leave is exhausted does not therefore arise.
