Standard schedule of rates – Constitution of a separate committee to fix standard schedule of Rates for different categories of works in place of single Board of Chief Engineers – Orders-issued.

ORDER:-

The present system of fixing standard schedule of rates by a single Board of Chief Engineers for all different kind of engineering works is leading to delay in compilation as well as finalization of revised rates of different types of works. During the discussions with the concerned Engineer-in-Chief, it is felt that it would be quicker and simpler if the standard schedule of rates for different items of work which are mostly in the domain of any specific department be finalized by the Engineer-in-Chief of the concerned department only.

2. After examining this point in the light of the views expressed by the Engineer-in-Chiefs, Government hereby decided to constitute 4 (four) separate Boards of Chief Engineers to fix the standard schedule of rates for the different items of work as under.

| a) Engineer-in-Chief | : For all irrigation and Drainage items of works |
| b) Engineer-in-Chief for R&B | : For all roads & Builds items of works |
| c) Engineer-in-Chief for public Health | : For water works & pipe line items and sewerage drainworks |
| d) Chief Engineer, Mechanical | : Lease and hire charge for Machinery use including rates for department machineries |

It is further ordered that both Engineer-in-Chief (R&B) and Engineer-in-Chief (Public Health Engineering department) will Co-opt one nominee of P.R. Engineering Department to their respective group for finalization of respective rates as the P.R. Department is engaged for construction of roads, buildings as well as drinking water works.

The rates fixed by the respective Boards shall be applicable for all works of that nature executed by all the Government departments and Government agencies and other bodies.

This order will take effect for fixation and finalization of SSRS for 1997-98.
