Minutes of the Meeting held in the Conference Hall by the Hon'ble Chief Minister to review and approve the welfare and other schemes for the Building and Other Construction Workers on 14.6.2010.

ORDER:-

Section 22 of the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 empowers the Board constituted under the Act to provide welfare measures and facilities to the Building and Other Construction Workers registered as beneficiaries with the Board.

- 2. The Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has resolved to provide certain welfare schemes to cover the beneficiaries registered with the Board. One, among these welfare schemes resolved to be implemented by the Board is the scheme for providing Funeral Expenses to the kith and kin of the deceased Building and Other Construction Worker and arrangement for transportation of the body to the native place within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- After examination, the Government hereby approve the scheme for providing Funeral Expenses to the kith and kin of the deceased Building and Other Construction Workers of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) in the case of death of registered workers with the following guidelines:-
 - The death of the worker should have occurred while working at the site or during the transit from residence to the work site, or vice versa or during the course of attending any work entrusted by the employer.
 - ii) The claimant should be kith and kin of the registered Building and Other Construction Worker with proper identification and the membership of the worker at the time of death should be live.
 - iii) Application for claiming the amount shall be in the Proformae prescribed and shall be accompanied by the Death Certificate of the deceased registered construction worker along with the photograph of the dead body and a photo copy of the Identity Card issued to the deceased worker.
 - iv) The concerned Assistant Labour Officer will conduct a local enquiry with the employer and the local authority, collect FIR copy / death certificate from

the Local Authority, as the case may be, and send a report to the Deputy Commissioner of Labour concerned.

- v) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour will sanction and release the amount of Rs.5000/- immediately soon after receipt of the enguiry report in full shape from the concerned Assistant Labour Officer along with the photograph of the dead body and a photo copy of the I.D. card issued to the deceased worker. The Board will provide adequate advance to each of the Deputy Commissioners of Labour in this regard and will be recouped from time to time.
- vi) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour will also arrange for transportation of the body of the deceased workers to the native place within the State of Andhra Pradesh in consultation with the RTO concerned and the Board will incur the transport expenses.
- vii) The Board will further issue the guidelines for the purpose of transportation of the dead body.
