Minutes of the Meeting held in the Conference Hall by the Hon'ble Chief Minister to review and approve the welfare and other schemes for the Building and Other Construction Workers on 14.6.2010.

ORDER:

On a complaint made to the National Human Rights Commission with regard to practice of Bonded Labour System in the Brick Kilns, Stone Quarries and Stone Crusher units in the State of Andhra Pradesh, more particularly, in Krishna district and based on the study report submitted by Dr. L. Mishra, Special Rapporteur to the National Human Rights Commission and after obtaining reports in the matter from the concerned, the Government, in order to achieve significant reduction in poverty among the above categories of workers, to minimize the vulnerability of workers to the bondage situation and to adopt convergence approach for extension of all the Government Schemes/Welfare Schemes of Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board / Central Government Schemes, applicable if any, to the workers engaged in Brick Kilns, Stone Quarries and Stone Crushers in the State, have got prepared a project report from the experts of the International Labour Organisation, Sub-Regional Office, New Delhi.

2. Section 22 of the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 empowers the Board constituted under the Act to provide welfare measures and facilities to the Building and Other Construction Workers registered as beneficiaries with the Board.

3. In the meeting held on 12.04.2010, the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has resolved to implement the Project prepared by the International Labour Organisation, Sub-Regional Office, New Delhi for the workers engaged in the Brick Kilns, Stone Quarries and Stone Crushers in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

4. Accordingly, the Government hereby approve the said Project for Reduction of Vulnerability of the Migrant Workers to be implemented by the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board.

5. Government also directs all the District Collectors, who are Nodal Agencies at the District level to work out appropriate modalities to implement the above Project successfully as directed by the National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi.
