Sub:- I & CAD Department – Minor Irrigation – Mission Kakatiya – Effective function of Mission Kakatiya Programme – Instructions – Issued.

Ref:- From the Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation, (K) Hyderabad, Letter No. CE-I/OTI.AEE4/Mission Kakatiya/Certain Instructions/2015-7, Dt.20.05.2015.

The attention of the Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation (Krishna Basin/ Godavari Basin), Hyderabad is invited to the references cited and he is informed that for effective functioning of Mission kakatiya Programme, the following instructions are issued:-

- 1) It is already instructed that wherever the farmers are coming forward to take the extra bill quantity than the provision made in the estimate to their field at their cost LS provisions made in the sanctioned estimate for conveyance of silt may be utilized for balance silt excavation (Basic rate Rs.40.10/Cum). This may be continued.
- 2) Wherever soils are not suitable for silt application as per Agriculture Department report, the Executive Engineers/ Superintending Engineers may be permitted to utilize the LS Provisions of lead charges provide in the estimates for 1 K.M conveyance to fill the old wells, strengthening of guide bank of surplus course and to dump at Government lands. The field officers should submit justification report, for utilization of land observe and compliance report.
- 3) Wherever, private persons are willing to take desilting soils which is not suitable for agriculture purpose and when demand is more open auction shall be conducted at Gramasabha and permitted to take the desilting soil duly paying the cost fixed at Gramasabha and from which segneriorage charges at Rs.22/- per Cum shall be paid to Government exchequer and balance amount shall be utilized for the development activities of village by the Grama Panchayat.
- 4) Wherever, desilting soils are useful for agriculture purpose and partly utilized by the farmer to their fields the balance silt quantity shall be disposed off as said in point (3) above.
- 5) For other provisions, the field engineers are instructed to follow the general rules in vogue for sanction of work slips/ deviations subject to condition that not to exceed the Administrative Approval Sanctions.

The CE, MI (GB/KB), Hyd, is therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions to the field Engineers accordingly.
