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Copy of the reference cited is sent herewith to the Engineer-in-Chief (R&B) National Highways, Telangana State, Hyderabad and he is requested to take necessary action on the following recommendations of the General Administration (Vigilance & Enforcement) Department and furnish action taken report to the Government.

1. Instruct the concerned Executive Engineers to effect the recoveries from the concerned agencies as per table mentioned in Appraisal Report.
  2. Deduct 0.4235% from the work bills towards insurance charges for all ongoing, completed works where 5% over head charges are added in the datas from 2015-2016 to till date.
  3. Add over head charges duly deducting insurance competent to data as recommended in the S.O.R for all works.
  4. Invoke clause 4(1) of Annexure-II of G.O.Ms.No.94, I&CAD (PW-COD) Dept., Dt.01.07.2003, against M/s. VKA Constructions.
  5. Take necessary steps to plan scrupulously to avoid delay in program of important works and to complete the work within the stipulated time as per agreement.
  6. Take consideration of Design parameters i.e., super elevation and Extra Widening in the Estimate.
  7. Take consideration of Road furniture i.e., Caution Boards, Sign Boards, Nomenclature Boards and KM & HM Stones, Lane marking and Studs in the Estimate.
  8. Ensure contraction & Expansion joint are provided as per IS 456 and these joints are filled properly with suitable sealant for C.C pavements.
  9. Instruct Q.C Wing to insist for ATR from field engineers on Q.C observations at regular basis.
  10. Instruct the Chief Engineer, Superintending Engineer & Executive Engineer to Impose LD's for the reason attributable to the contractor if any, at the time of granting EOAT's.
