Sub: Accounts – APEWIDC – Enhancement of PS & MS charges of APEWIDC from existing rate of 3% to 7% for the survival of the Corporation – Allotment of PS & MS charges out of the enhanced charges by the Division Offices to the Head quarters office of APEWIDC, the three Circle Offices and the Q.C. Wing including three Q.C. Sub-Division Offices – Orders – Issued – Reg.

ORDER:

The Government in Education Department have issued orders in G.O.Ms.No.107, Education (TRG) Department, dated 30.08.2008, for creation of APEWIDC as new Corporation by merging the erstwhile Social Welfare Engineering Wing of APSCCFC Ltd., along with staff and assets. There is no budgetary grant to APEWIDC to meet the expenditure on the salaries of the staff of this Corporation and maintenance of all the offices in the District Corporation sustains only on its own earnings through Petty Supervision and Major Supervision (PS & MS) charges which are only receivable when contractual payments are arranged.

2) The (23) Division Offices in the (23) Districts of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States are levying 3% of PS & MS Charges on the works being executed by them and they are utilizing the said amount to meet the expenditure on the salaries of the employees working in their Division Offices and Sub-Division Offices and office maintenance purpose. The (3) Circle Offices are getting certain income on Bid processing charges and they are utilizing the said amount to meet the expenditure on the salaries of the employees working in Circle Offices and for office maintenance purpose as per this office Circular Memo No.AE4/GC/MD/APEWIDC/2009, dated 17.05.2010.

3) In the regard to the expenditure on the salaries of the employees working in Headquarters Office and for office maintenance, the Government, in Education Department while, setting-up of the APEWIDC with participation from School Education Department, Social Welfare Department, B.C. Welfare Department, Minorities Welfare Department and Higher Education Department, vide G.O.Ms.No.107, Education (TRG) Department, dated 30.08.2008, has mentioned in Para (13) of the said G.O that, an amount of Rs.5.00 Crores will be given as



advance (to be later adjusted to works) to the Corporation by the participating Departments of School Education, Higher Education, Social Welfare, B.C. Welfare and Minorities Welfare Departments in the ratio of Rs.1.5 Crores each by Social Welfare and School Education Departments, Rs.0.75 Crores by Higher Education and B.C.W. Departments, and Rs.0.50 Crores by Minorities Welfare Department to enable the proposed Corporation to start its operations with building, equipments, computers etc, as an initial startup amount. But, none of the participating departments could provide this initial startup amount despite constant persuasion. The Corporate office has experienced lot of difficulty in meeting its day to day maintenance of office expenditure and payment of salaries to the existing staff. In such circumstances, the interest accrued on the deposits made by the State Project Director, RVM (SSA), A.P., Hyderabad, is being utilized for the maintenance of office expenditure of Corporate Office and payment of salaries of the staff working in the Corporate Office including Chief Engineer and Managing Director. And a proposal has been made in the meeting of the Managing Committee of APEWIDC which met on 31.10.2009 and 26.04.2010 through an Agenda Item, for utilization of the interest accrued on the works deposits made by the State Project Director, RVM (SSA), A.P., Hyderabad towards KGBV Ph.-III and Ph.-IV works. The Managing Committee which met on 26.04.2010 has ratified the action of the Managing Director of APEWIDC to meet the expenditure on the Corporate Office initially from the accrued interest and recoup the amount from out of the Petty Supervision & Major Supervision charges.

4) Accordingly, the expenditure on the salaries of the staff working in the Headquarters Office is being met from the interest amount. Further, the salaries of the staff working in the Q.C. Wing and the three Q.C. Sub-Division Offices are also being met by the Headquarters Office from the interest amount. The deposits made by the State Project Director, RVM (SSA), A.P., Hyderabad, have already been utilized for the purpose and there is no other source for getting interest amount to the Headquarters Office.

5) Based on the proposal dated 09.11.2009 submitted by the Corporate Office of APEWIDC, for enhancing the MS/PS charges from the existing 3% to 7%, the Government in School Education (TRG) Department have issued orders, permitting the Managing Director, APEWIDC, to enhance the MS/PS charges from 3% to 7% and to levy the same on all the works executed by the Corporation, vide reference 1st read above. And the G.O. was communicated to all the Executive Engineers of APEWIDC, vide this office Endt.No.A1/160/MD/APEWIDC/2009, dt.22.09.2015.

6) In the above circumstances, it has been considered to get certain percentage from the PS & MS charges being levied by the Division Offices in both the States in order to meet the expenditure on the salaries of the staff working in the Headquarters Office of APEWIDC, the three Circle Offices and the Q.C. Wing including the three Q.C. Sub-Divisions and for office maintenance of the above said offices.



7) Accordingly, all the (13) Division Offices in the State of Andhra Pradesh, shall remit two percent (2%) of PS & MS charges to the Headquarters office of APEWIDC, for salaries and maintenance of Corporate Office, Q.C. Wing staff including three Sub-Divisions and Circle Office staff.

8) The Executive Engineers are directed to remit 2% of PS/MS charges:

Divisions executing the works in (13) Districts of Andhra Pradesh shall have to remit two percent (2%) of MS/PS charges to	Savings Bank Account of APEWIDC (Andhra Pradesh) No.3355100001, IFS Code. No.CBIN0281442 of Central Bank of India, Himayathnagar Branch, Hyderabad.

The Executive Engineers of APEWIDC are directed to submit monthly accounts indicating the payments made through PAO/APAO and by the Executive Engineers at Division level along with the particulars of 2% MS/PS charges, to the Corporate Office by 10th of succeeding month without fail. Any deviation in this regard, will be viewed seriously.

9) The Executive Engineers of APEWIDC of (13) Divisions of Andhra Pradesh State, shall take necessary action as per the orders in Paras (7) and (8) above, with immediate effect.
